Hello Caroline

Assessing current levels of wood borer beetle activity will be difficult outside of the flight season (the only way to confirm activity is to find emerging adults in the flight season – roughly March – July). However an assessment of magnitude and extent of fungal decay and wood borer damage could be achieved. In this case a microdrill (which I use) would be very useful. A report would be issued including observations and recommendations which would detail extent of damage and appropriate forms of remediation.

It would seem the entire Lychgate structure requires assessment. The cost for this, inclusive of all travel and production of the report, would be £1220 + VAT.

The next stage, where the piers/timber have been structurally weakened, would be to engage a firm who deals with historical timber monuments. Any replacements should be of pre-treated timber.
