Hi Caroline

Here are our thoughts for the 'Slow Down' poster competition:

- Limit the entries to 50 (more than that could be difficult to source the paper and find where to put them all up?)
- 2 age group categories 8-12 and under 8 with a £25 prize for each (we will provide)
- A3 size card to be collected from Rose and Crown along with competition instructions.
- Completed entries to be handed in at Rose and Crown
- Competition advertised on Cuckfield Gossip and Rose and Crown website/social media (see below)
- A week to complete posters and hand in.



Posters to be judged by a small number of (socially distanced) judges.
1 parish councillor, Rose & Crown representative & possibly member of Speed Watch group?



- 2 winning posters will be posted near Rose & Crown
- Remaining posters to be set up along London Road, London Lane, High Street & Broad Street...both directions by us. Or by Speed Watch Group or take direction from them?

Question:

In a perfect world it would be good to get the posters laminated (at our expense) do you have access to a laminator or know of any we could use?

Suggested Wording for social media posting:

SLOW DOWN PLEASE! Children's poster competition £25 Prize

Some of the residents of Cuckfield have become concerned with the speed at which cars seem to be travelling through the village during this current 'stay at home' period.

We would like children to design a 'Slow Down' poster to be posted on the main roads through the village.

There will be 2 £30 prizes, one for children under 8 years old and one for 8-12 year olds.

Card and instructions are available to be collected from the Rose & Crown pub.

Entries will be limited to a total of 50.

Suggested wording of instructions and rules:

- Please use the A3 card provided (there will be a total maximum of 50 available)
- Name, age and contact information to be written on the back of the entry
- Return the poster entry to the Rose & Crown pub by.....(date to be determined)
- There will be 2 £25 prizes awarded, one in each category : 8-12 years old and under 8
- Poster content is up to the individual but must include the words:

SLOW DOWN!



Max 30 mph
