Hi Sam

We are in the process finally of getting the new defibs up long story as the one in the high street is not functioning again

Wednesday next week one of the new ones is going up there in it's place
we have finally now got permission and licence from the HH council to fit the one at whitemans green as well

Both units are coded cabinets - we propose that you hold the details at the council as a point of contact and you hold the agreed parties contact details for sorting out any issues - please see attached sheet - which gives full details of parties willing to be part of the process..
It also contains details of the ongoing fundraising and where the money will be held - so that when the units need pads or batteries pads in 2021 and batteries in 2023 - there should be enough in the kitty to pay for these items - we are currently holding £400 in the ISOC account specifically for the maintenance of the 2 new units.

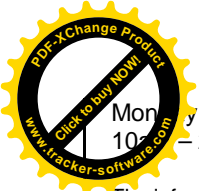
