Dear Cuckfield Parish Council,

I wanted you to be aware that on the 10th, 11th and 12th July up to 300 children (per day) and staff from Warden Park Secondary Academy will be passing through the Parish on a Charity Walk. The walk is to promote and raise funds for three local charities: Kangaroos, The Starlight Foundation and St Peters and St James Hospice as well as the RSPCA.

The walk will be nearly 8 miles long and will leave our site in Broad Street Cuckfield around 9.30 returning shortly before 3pm. We start by walking down Horsgate Lane and then onto the Borde Hill Estate. Our route then takes us to Brook St and down towards Whiteman's Green via the Cuckfield Golf Centre. We expect to have a picnic lunch at Whiteman's Green and we then plan to come into Cuckfield Village at the back of Ockendon Manor then passing by the church before going by Laines Farm and across the bypass. We will then return to school along Copyhold Lane.
