Hi Colin

I made a few notes, as follows:

The pavement gains identified by WSCC in their original plans were not achieved. RS explained that it was not until the project team were on site and started work that it could be established that it would not be possible to increase the pavement as expected, due to the lack of highway available. Learnings from this project were that it would be better to review projects like this in 2 stages; although the costs may be marginally higher, the potential savings realised by not proceeding with a project that was not viable would be great.

Several options were discussed to find alternative ways of improving London Lane and make it safer; there were:

- Make London Lane one way, diverting traffic along Broad Street and the High Street. This could be either all the way along London Lane, or leave it 2 way between London Road and Glebe Road, and one way from Glebe Road to Broad Street.
- Close London Lane and make it a cul de sac.
- Install buildouts along the road to slow traffic.
- Install bollards at the entrance to London Lane (Broad Street?) to prevent vehicles wider than the 6'6" travelling along London Lane.

SID data would be collected to establish the number of large vehicles which use London Lane, Broad Street and the High Street.

The costs for changing the road to one way would be fairly low, at approx. £10k for a TRO and new signage.
