Dear Caroline,

If we were to resurface all the paths within the churchyard our prices would be as follows;

Main Churchyard.

Cut back vegetation at edges of paths and clear arisings from site.
Excavate for and install treated softwood timber edging secured with treated softwood pegs at 1m centres.
Apply weedkiller to the entire surface of the footway.
Apply a tack coat of bituminous emulsion.
Supply and lay by hand 6mm dense bituminous macadam surface course to an average depth of 30mm but allowing for any additional depth required to improve surface levels all well rolled and compacted to a uniform and even surface.
Make good to verges with topsoil and seed.
Clear all surplus materials and leave site clean and tidy.

In all approximately 970m² all for the sum of £41,522 excluding V.A.T.

Churchyard bounded by Church Platt and Newbury Lane.

Carry out all preparatory works and resurfacing as noted above but to an area of 430m², all for the sum of £18,407 excluding V.A.T.

Small individual areas as shown on the attached photographs;

Carry out all preparatory work and resurfacing to individual isolated areas;

Photo 1	an area of approximately 96m ² for the sum of £2,901 excluding V.A.T.
Photo 2	an area of approximately 21m ² all for the sum of £1,499 excluding V.A.T.
Photo 3	an area of approximately 13m ² all for the sum of £928 excluding V.A.T.
Photo 4/5	an area of approximately 31m ² plus rebuild step to Newbury Lane all for the sum of £2,812 excluding V.A.T.
Photo 6/7	an area of approximately 15m ² plus rebuild step to Newbury Lane all for the sum of £1,670 excluding V.A.T.

From the above figures it is fairly obvious that there are significant economies of scale; the larger the area the lower the rate per m². We would be happy to discuss in greater detail any proposals you might want to put forward to achieve the best value.

This quotation is subject to our standard terms and conditions as attached and the following;

Nett payment within 21 days from date of invoice.
One visit to site for completion of the whole of the works.
V.A.T. to be added to the account at the rate applicable at the time the works are carried out.
