We received notification today of proposed tree felling of the Ash trees with die back in London Lane, following the road widening scheme in the summer.

Could I also bring to your attention the extremely large Ash tree between my property, Tregarth, London lane and the Cuckfield village Hall/Play group. This tree also has die back (can provide photos taken in the summer) and is a persistent and serious danger to both us and the children and users of the Village Hall.

Is it possible to have this tree felled whilst the tree surgeons are in the vicinity as it poses a serious threat and regularly drops large branches through my green house roof
